A prayer fervently offered by the Honorable Councilor Lourdes Casabuena signaled the opening of the session. The community singing of the Philippine National Anthem and the General Santos City Hymn were led by the General Santos City Performing Arts Choir Division. The chair thanked the choir and in behalf of the 18<sup>th</sup> SP Council expressed its condolences to Councilor Rosalita Nuñez for the death of her sister-in-law. Thereupon she acknowledged the presence of some guests particularly Engr. Crisanto Sotelo, SOCOTECO II manager and after which informed that their invited guests supposedly to appear today namely, Atty. Armando Clarin of the City Legal Office, Engr. Bernadette Francisco and Engr. Joseph Nael Cruzpero of City Planning Office had instead requested for an executive session due to the complexity of the issues to be discussed. There was also a suggestion to invite Ms. Mary Ann Bacar of the City Housing in this session to clarify issues propounded by some urban poor resident rallying in front of the Sangguniang Panlungsod building. Thereafter the chair called the session to order and the roll call followed. There being a quorum, the chair ruled to proceed to the next business.

**F. READING AND ADOPTION OF MINUTES : 31<sup>ST</sup> REGULAR SESSION**

On separate motions of Councilor Bagonoc jointly seconded by Councilors Pacquiao, Acharon, Pestaño, Congson and Casabuena, the reading of the minutes was dispensed with and eventually it was approved without any correction.

## G. PRIVILEGE HOUR:

### 1. Hon. Dominador S. Lagare, Jr.

Councilor Lagare in his privilege speech informed the body that he was chosen as one of the resource speakers to the 1<sup>st</sup> Latin American Conference on Intelligent Transportation Systems and ANDINA Traffic Seminar on Transit and Transportation Planning which will be held in Bogota, Colombia on March 29, 2017. Accordingly, he was given a slot of 20 minutes to speak and his speech entitled "People's Organizations Thru the Concept of Cooperativism: Tactical Solution to Solving Traffic Congestion in the City" was already sent to Colombia to be translated into Spanish as it is their native tongue there. Thereupon, he read his speech in its entirety which he is going to deliver and he admitted that more than anything else, he would want to share the beauty of General Santos City as a whole and not just on transportation issues.

At this juncture the privileged speaker responded to some queries and issues raised by the honorable members and after which the chair recognized the next speaker.

### 2. Hon. Jose Orlando R. Acharon

Councilor Acharon when recognized yielded the floor to Ms. Baby Asuncion Rodriguez, the president of the GSC Consumer Welfare Council, Inc. to address some concerns regarding rice problems in the city. Under suspended rules, Ms. Rodriguez assured that the supply of rice in the city is sufficient and there are two kinds of rice supply, the NFA and the fancy rice (*Wow Rice, Wow Bigas, Sandomeng, Bordagol*). The NFA rice has also two kinds – the ordinary which is priced at P27.00 and the P32.00 per kilo which accordingly could compete the commercial fancy rice sold quite exorbitantly in the market. The fancy rice she said is not under the suggested retail price (SRP) of the NFA but under the control of consumers continuously buying and when the supply is insufficient the price increases. She encouraged to educate the consumers to buy/patronize the NFA rice as it is not only affordable but also cost-saving – one way of improving economy.

Ms. Rodriguez at this juncture addressed some points of interest, queries and other matters aired by the honorable members as to alleged malpractices of traders/millers like re-milling, hoarding, mixing NFA rice with fancy rice and other concerns. After which, the privileged speaker after thanking Ms. Rodriguez introduced Engr. Sotelo, to clarify about the frequent brownouts in the city.

When recognized by the chair, Engr. Sotelo narrated to the body the summary of brownout incidents and what trigger these that cause the power interruptions for a total of 503 minutes. He emphasized that these interruptions were not about power supply because SOCOTECO II he said is being sufficiently supplied by different Independent Power Producers (IPPs) and NPC-PSALM coming from Agus Complex, Pulangi, the Sarangani Energy Corporation (coal plant), Mt. Apo Geothermal Plant in Kidapawan and the Therma South or the Aboitiz Coal Plant. They have also their BOT (Build-Operate & Transfer) diesel bunkered power plant in Apopong.

Responding to queries, Engr. Sotelo said SOCOTECO II is part of the City Development Council and they are constantly participating in the deliberations regarding future power requirements of the city in the advent of more industrialization, business and metropolitan urbanization development. Just recently he said, SOCOTECO II has entered into a renewable energy supply agreement with a certain biomass plant located near Cotabato City.

More issues and concerns were discussed and after which the chair thanked Engr. Sotelo for his valuable presence today and thereafter, acting on the motion presented thereupon ruled for the resumption of the rules and further ruled to proceed to the next business.

It was also advised that the lawyer of the urban poor association should file a manifestation in court to delay the demolition pending the pre-demolition conference to be conducted by the participating agencies involved in the process of relocating the urban poor.

The chair informed that their scheduled conference with the Internal Audit as regards their SLAN was moved next session due to time constraints.
