City Councilor Shandee Theresa O. Llido-Pestaño called the hearing to order to discuss the above agendum and after which was the acknowledgment of everyone's presence.

Councilor Bagonoc manifested that she is representing Councilor Casabuena who is attending to an equally important matter.

When asked, Mr. Nurhasan Juanday of PESO-Gensan manifested that it has been their practice to furnish Barangay San Isidro with the list of job vacancies monthly but he is not aware if the new PESO manager who is currently attending a meeting at the City Mayor's Office is still continuing the same practice. He said there is only a need for the barangay PESO manager to be aggressive in getting the list of job vacancies from PESO-Gensan. Having been clarified that the request of Barangay San Isidro for this measure is limited only within its area of responsibility, he assured to take note of the same.

Councilor Bagonoc appreciated the PESO for doing so much in terms of job placements in the city and also in the implementation of this ordinance, that's why she favored this measure.

When given the floor, Ms. Fatima Quorayce L. Bataga, representative of the Department of Labor and Employment was thankful to the establishments in Gensan for submitting their job vacancies and placements to DOLE, which enabled them to have a true picture of the employment data in General Santos City. As to the barangays, she was amenable that the barangays would have their own data within their area of responsibility so that they could specifically attend to the needs of their constituents in terms of employment. As to employment and unemployment rate, DOLE has no data for the City of General Santos since their data are also coming from the National Statistics Office which is now the Philippine Statistics Authority. Starting 2004, the data of NSO are already by region.

At this point, Councilor Bagonoc asked some information regarding the alleged job hiring opportunities outside the country, and also brought out some other related issues, which Ms. Bataga satisfactorily answered.

Ensuing further deliberations, upon motion for approval filed by Councilor Bagonoc, the chair ruled this item approved in the committee level and to be calendared for second reading this coming Tuesday's regular session, with Councilors Casabuena, Pestaño, Bagonoc and Yumang as the main sponsors.

There being no matters to discuss, the chair declared the joint committee hearing adjourned at 4:15 o'clock in the afternoon.
