A prayer song and the community singing of the Philippine National Anthem and the General Santos City Hymn were led by the General Santos City Performing Arts Choir Division. Thereupon she acknowledged the presence of guests in the gallery who are from DepEd, the Alliance of Concerned Teachers Union of Region XII and some invited city government departments heads. Thereafter the chair called the session to order and the roll call followed. There being a quorum, the chair ruled to proceed to the next business.

F. READING AND ADOPTION OF MINUTES : 40TH REGULAR SESSION

On separate motions of Councilor Bagonoc jointly seconded by Councilors Acharon, Yumang and Casabuena, the reading of the minutes was dispensed with and eventually it was approved without any correction.

MINUTES OF THE 40TH REGULAR SESSION – ADOPTED

G. PRIVILEGE HOUR:

1. Hon. Franklin M. Gacal, Jr.
2. Hon. Brix T. Tan

The first speaker, Councilor Franklin Gacal, Jr. when recognized expressed his frustration and said that until today, the Small Town Lottery (STL) still illegally operates in the city with impunity. Two weeks ago he had deferred his privilege speech relative to this effect in deference to the request of the city mayor to allow him first settle the issue. He said it bewilders him now why the parties involved in the operation of STL, the

Philippine Charity Sweepstakes (PCSO), and the Trento Gaming Corporation still refuse to follow Republic Act 9649, and the city executive department refuses to implement the said law. The law states “any person must seek the prior consent of the city government thru the city mayor and concurrence of the sangguniang panlungsod in order to operate any form of authorized gambling such as those under PCSO or PAGCOR.”

The privileged speaker furthered that few days from now, he will be conducting the first committee hearing because months ago, an operator of e-bingo under the auspices of PAGCOR and two more applicants were required to get the approval of the SP pursuant of RA 9649. He then asked what is so special with STL or Trento Gaming Corporation that it is seemingly exempt from following the law or above the law. He said there are four of them lawyers in this August Hall and they as lawmakers would not allow that the laws of the republic and the city ordinances will just be trampled upon by non-residents of the city. By allowing the illegal operation of STL in the city, he said they lose the moral authority to require their constituents to obey local laws or ordinances.

Councilor Galal enumerated more national laws about gambling, its implementing rules and regulations and other local ordinances and more particularly the stiff penalty provisions to government official/personnel for failure to follow the rules of law to this effect. The advisers of the city executive should be alarmed on this provision or otherwise, they should better go back to law school he added.

Moreover, Councilor Galal mentioned the prescribed law on sharing percentage that should accrue to the city, to the province, to the congressional district and other regional, local government offices out of the operation of this authorized gambling. Because he said, failure to attain and meet on time the Prospective Monthly Retail Revenue is a ground for cancellation. He also mentioned some process/procedural violations committed by STL. As chairman of the Committee on Games and Amusements, he is demanding from the executive department that the continued operation of Trento Gaming Corporation in the city without business permit and consent from the Sangguniang Panlungsod is a blatant and flagrant violation of the existing laws that it shall be abated or put to hold.

At this juncture, a lengthy discussion followed concerning gambling operations, the (illegal) proliferations of STL outlets in the city, including that of the lotto operation where the body took advantage of the presence of Ms. Geraldine Zamora, the head of the Permits and Licenses Division. Thereupon, more issues and concerns were discussed and after which the chair thanked Councilor Galal and then ruled to proceed to the next speaker.

The next speaker, Councilor Tan deferred his privilege speech and yielded the floor to Councilor Casabuena. The latter when recognized acknowledged the presence of some officials and members of the Alpha Phi Omega (APO) Fraternity in which it held its 9th Alpha Phi Omega National Biennial General Assembly in the city last May 26-28, 2017. It was held in Lagao Gym accordingly attended by 3,500 delegates not only coming from several cities, municipalities and provinces in the country but also as far as from Canada, US and the Middle East. If not for the Marawi crisis, the delegates would have reached 5,000.

Under suspended rules, Mr. Arbis in behalf of the Alpha Phi Omega Philippines, Inc. and the APO worldwide, he thanked the city government through City Mayor Rivera and Senator Manny Pacquiao for making their activity successful. It was said that the declaration of martial law in Mindanao had made the delegates safer. After some more deliberations, Councilor Casabuena informed that she will be passing a resolution commending the APO Fraternity for choosing Gen. Santos City as their venue. A photo op with the group followed.

J. QUESTION AND ANSWER HOUR:

As suggested and discussed, there will be a close door conference with the City Mayor along with the PNP officials as regards security plan as a consequence of the declaration of martial law in the entire island of Mindanao. It was also recommended that inspection at check points should be more rigid than usual.

As regards the elevator and under suspended rules Engr. Oponda informed that the problem on elevator was its multi-beam sensor. Its installation, replacement and repair will cost P75,000.00. Since the Sanggunian has a P90 Thousand fund for the repair, they need a certification in order to process the PR. Its monthly maintenance is P5,000.00 excluding spare parts. The other proposal costs the city P15 thousand per month inclusive of major and minor spare parts replacement which he believed is disadvantageous to the city. The chair said she will give the decision to the office concerned to decide so long it will be repaired the soonest.

With the presence of Engr. Signar matters concerning the proposed flood way project in Aradaza Gensanville, road right of way issues and concerns, presence of informal settlers along the road right of way, and opening of some roads were addressed by Engr. Signar. When asked by the chair if the good engineer could again present the master drainage plan to update the body as to its progress, Engr. Signar was amenable to present the same next session during the privilege hour. He was advised to coordinate with Councilor Pacquiao or Councilor Melliza.

As to the drainage flooding along Quirino Ave. corner Magsaysay Ave. and also in the Corner of Calina Street-Ladrera in front of Agan Lagao, Engr. Signar said the project along Quirino is implemented by the DPWH and he promised to coordinate with the said office. While the flooding at Calina St. he said they are now replacing the old reinforced concrete-type culverts with big size box-type culverts which he said is included in his report next week.

The recurring problem on the long overdue house electrification at Prk. 10 Lanton, Brgy. Apopong, it was decided to bring this matter to the City Legal Office, to the City Administrator, the OBO and the City Housing. It was also suggested to invite SOCOTECO II and the OBO.

K. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The chair was inviting everyone to attend the lecture of Prof. Eric Zerrudo with respect to the infamous Juan Luna Painting on May 31, 2017, to be held at the SP session hall, dinner time. Next Wednesday morning

at around ten o'clock at the VM Conference Room, all councilors were encouraged to come for a meeting to discuss several concerns. They might as well schedule their executive session in the afternoon thereof with the City Mayor.
