A prayer song and the community singing of the Philippine National Anthem and the General Santos City Hymn were led by the General Santos City Performing Arts Choir Division. The choir likewise rendered birthday songs to the Honorable Vice Mayor whose birthday will be tomorrow, June 28, 2017. After thanking the choir, the chair acknowledged the presence of some students under the International Exchange Scholar Program, other invited guests, the Dean and the Secretary of the MSU College of Law Extension, Atty. Alizedney Ditucalan and Dr. Anshari P. Ali, respectively; Atty. Eliseo Vencer II; other notable officials and educators; visitors in the gallery, and other employees and staff. Thereafter the session was called to order and the roll call followed. Since there was no enough members to muster a quorum the chair declared a few minutes recess.

With the arrival of Councilor Jose Orlando Acharon in which there were already seven members present, and there being a quorum, the chair thereupon ruled to proceed to the next business.

On separate motions of Councilor Vandyke Congson jointly seconded by Councilors Nuñez, Yumang and Casabuena, the reading of the minutes was dispensed with and eventually, it was approved without any correction.

MINUTES OF THE 44TH REGULAR SESSION – ADOPTED

G. PRIVILEGE HOUR:

1. Hon. Jose Edmar J. Yumang

In his privilege speech, Councilor Jose Edmar Yumang commended the three young athlete-students who brought gold, silver and bronze medals in the swimming competition when they compete in the recent *Palarong Pambansa* which was held in Antique on April 21-27, 2017. They are Thea Diane Soguilon Canda,

(Gold in 4x100 meter medley relay, Gold in 400-meter Freestyle and setting a new time record of 4.47.7, and Silver in 200- meter Freestyle); Kelsey Claire Jaudian, Silver in 200-meter butterfly stroke and Bronze in 800-meter Freestyle; and Krisha Joanna, Apin three Gold medals, (Gold for 200-meter Freestyle, Gold for 100 meters Freestyle and Gold for 4x100 medley relay and Bronze in 50-meter Freestyle). The August Body lauded their extraordinary feat, their perseverance and determination and prayed that this feat will be the beginning of more great things to come for them.

Secondly, Councilor Yumang likewise expressed his personal felicitations to the Mindanao State University-College of Law Extension of this city for its 25th years of existence. As an alumnus he said he joins the celebration of MSU and with pride commemorates its achievements and years of excellence that despite its humble beginnings, it has constantly produced a number of lawyers every bar exam. The last batch of MSU-Gensan bar examinees yielded 28 new lawyers. He thanked the pioneers who envisage the putting up of a law school, labored for the realization of that vision and in pioneering the institution. Likewise, all the professors who served more than a decade and still serving the institution and it was his hope he said that MSU-GSC College of Law Extension will produce more and more lawyers to serve not only the government but also in private practice.

At this instance, Councilor Yumang introduced to the body the new Dean of the MSU College of Law, Atty. Alizedney Ditucalan; Atty. Eliseo Vencer II, one of the first batches of dedicated and highly esteemed Law Professors; Atty. Anshari Ali, the College of Law Secretary. Likewise, he mentioned all the law alumni who had served and those still serving and pioneering the noble cause of their institution. It is of great privilege he said to exalt their significant contributions in the field of law, producing great lawyers at par with prominent and famous law schools in the National Capital Region.

Under suspended rules, Atty. Eliseo Vencer II one of the pioneering professors said that the MSU-College of Law was conceived to help the less fortunate attain law education because as noticed, only the rich can obtain legal education there in Manila and in other cities. And from scratch they were able to assemble a committed faculty with only their great confidence and ability to produce lawyers as their motivation or driving force. Despite monumental limitations like the lack of facilities – buildings, library, they were able to produce 12 lawyers for the first time at the first strike. They are here today he said to thank this August Body and the city government for the honor, recognition and encouragement it bestowed to them. It is their hope that these gestures will be translated into concrete moves to assist the law school that someday it can produce not only graduates but topnotchers and foremost, General Santos City would be a beehive of intellectual excellence. Atty. Ditucalan, the Dean of the College of Law also shared his piece and was hopeful that the MSU and this LGU would have a strong partnership through a premium educational learning center since the existence of the College of Law is essential for community development particularly so in the strengthening of the ASEAN economic integration.

Following a quite lengthy deliberation and thereupon the August Body through the Acting Vice Mayor Elizabeth Bagonoc presented the plaques of recognition signed by the Vice Mayor Shirlyn Bañas-Nogralas to Atty. Ditucalan, Atty. Vencer and to Dr. Ali. Certificates of Recognition were also awarded to the foregoing bemedalled swimming-athletes. A photo opportunity with them followed.

2. Hon. Lourdes F. Casabuena

Councilor Lourdes Casabuena first acknowledged the presence of the barangay officials around and thereupon informed that on June 19, 2017, the first Barangay Competitiveness Ranking in the Philippines unveiled the winners of the 2017 Most Competitive Barangay during the 1st General Santos City Barangay Competitiveness Summit held at Tierra Montana Hotel, this city. The barangay competitiveness summit she said recognizes the barangay effort and its pace towards public service delivery based on the barangay pillars of competitiveness. Thereupon, she yielded the floor to Engr. Rizza Paches who gave a background as to what this program all about in which a video presentation was shown primarily emphasizing its general objectives and the correlation of all the indicators to provide a ranking. For the final ranking, the top most competitive barangay was Lagao, No. 2 – Calumpang; No. 3 – Fatima; No. 4 – Dadiangas South and No. 5- Apopong. These barangays would receive monetary incentives to be used in programs that they would want to implement to improve services. The No. 1 receives P200 Thousand, No. 2 – P175, No. 3 – P150, No. 4 – P100, No. 5 – P50. The funding to this effect was a built-in fund of the CEMCDO approved in the AIP and was included in the regular budget program of the office under Investment Promotion/Service and Facilitation.

With the several issues and concerns brought to her end, Engr. Paches said they have scheduled several interactions with the bottom 10 barangays as the priority beneficiaries for trainings and livelihood assistance and other interventions. The capacitation of these bottom 10 barangays would be in terms of how they are going to build up their data.

A quite lengthy deliberation followed where more barangay issues and concerns relative to the ranking was discussed. Since the program was to be held annually and this was just starting, they expect hitches, humps and bumps but there will be improvement they said as they learn through experience. Reportedly, the City of

General Santos was the first to conduct this barangay competitiveness ranking. The August Body was hopeful that this achievement of CEMCDO will be included in the guidelines for another award for the city and as such entitled to another productivity bonus.

A photo op with the barangay officials followed.

Still under suspended rules, at the instance of Councilor Nuñez, Ms. Noralyn Joy Ramos, the Sending Coordinator of the American Field Scholarship Inter-cultural Program Philippines (AFS-IPP), which is the implementing body of the Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange & Study Program, an 11-month exchange program in the USA, introduced to the body the three returning scholars, namely, Al Benzhar Abdul Lumanggal, of Buayan National High School, hosted in Washington, USA; and Ryjean Quent Andiam Kamid of Tinagacan National High School, hosted in South Carolina, USA; and Shar Jathiya Anabo Sheik of MSU, hosted in Maine, USA.

The two students due to leave this August, 2017 to avail of the same scholarship program are Kimbian Sillo Lim from Fatima National High School and Nur Al Hayah Matabalao and will be hosted in Florida, USA. A photo opportunity with the scholars then followed. Thereafter, the suspension of the rules was lifted and the body proceeded to the main business.

J. QUESTION AND ANSWER HOUR:

As an offshoot to the manifestations made last session, Ms. Rebecca Magante, the City Social Welfare & Development Officer and under suspended, presented a video showing the data on the internally displaced persons (IDPs) who are now in the city coming from Marawi and from the neighboring towns or province of Lanao del Sur. The data show the act, the date of arrival, the date they assessed, number of families, number

of dependents, host families, and the specific barangay where they are currently located. Barangay Bula reportedly has the highest number of IDPs. There were a total of 522 families with 1,961 dependents and an overall total of 2,483 individuals. It also showed the list of items and services provided and extended such as psychosocial processes and the schoolchildren were admitted in some city's schools as there was accordingly an instruction from the Secretary of Education to admit the schoolchildren of IDPs even without documents.

Further, Ms. Magante informed that institutionally, the Crisis Management Committee had agreed that the security forces will conduct four areas of military procedures in four sites within the city – entrance and exits. She admitted that the PNP/Joint Task Force (JTF) does the profiling process of IDPs before they are referred to their office and they are closely coordinating with the law enforcement agencies, she added. The IDPs were also issued family cards and they also consented to have IDs to be issued by the CDRRMC.

Other concerns such as curfew will be discussed further by the concerned agencies including the barangay captains. Ms. Magante also committed to furnish the councilors updates on the status of the city's community-base drug program. As to gang war where three minors reportedly died, Councilor Casabuena said this will be included in her privilege speech next session. The security briefing for the councilors will be referred to the City Vice Mayor she being the acting mayor.

As to the possible amendment of the Tax Revenue Code of the city, Councilor Melliza said he had already written the City Legal Office. It was also suggested to seek the consent of the executive to this effect before they will initiate the filing of an amendatory provision on the tax code.

K. ANNOUNCEMENT:

Lastly, the chair informed the body and all the employees and visitors that as directed by the vice mayor, there will be strict implementation of security measures in the SP building and in the city hall. All are required to wear their IDs and visitors will be given visitor's pass. The councilors asked that they will be given their IDs which was a long overdue request. The Secretary was requested to facilitate such request.

L. ADJOURNMENT :

There being no more matter to discuss and as moved by Councilor Nuñez duly seconded by Councilor Acharon, the chair thereupon ruled the session adjourned at about 12:22 past noon.
