AGENDUM:

SPPO NO. 1718-0141 – AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AS HERITAGE ZONE THE GENERAL SANTOS CITY PIONEER’S PARK PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR ITS PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR (Hon. Shirlyn L. Bañas- Nograles-Author; Hon. Shandee Theresa O. Llido-Pestaño, Hon. Brix T. Tan & Hon. Ramon R. Melliza-Sponsors)

The hearing was presided by Councilor Shandee Theresa O. Llido-Pestaño to discuss the aforementioned agendum.

Inasmuch as Mr. Teodulo Ramirez was not aware that the General Santos Park was already renamed, this item was momentarily laid on the table for Mr. George Tapel to secure the ordinance to this effect to support his manifestation that it was really renamed as confirmed by Mr. Nur Juanday.

When the discussion continued, Section 4 was amended to read as: **Section 4. ENFORCEMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION.** *"The Office of the City Mayor shall promulgate an IRR for the implementation and enforcement of this ordinance".*

Upon motion filed by Councilor Bagonoc, duly seconded by Councilor Casabuena, the chair ruled the said amendment approved, subject to style.

AMENDMENT-APPROVED, SUBJECT TO STYLE

When this item was taken out from the table, Mr. George Tapel in reference to Ordinance No. 4, series of 2007 passed by the sanggunian informed that different parks in the city were renamed as follows:

- From Carlos P. Garcia Park situated at southern portion of the city, renamed to "*Plaza Heneral Santos*";
- From General Park situated along P. Acharon Boulevard, Barangay Dadiangas West, renamed to "*Pioneer's Park*"; and
- From the name Freedom park situated in the northern portion of government center, renamed to "*Carlos P. Garcia Park*".

With the foregoing, Mr. Ramirez was enlightened and upon motion of Councilor Casabuena, duly seconded by Councilor Bagonoc, the chair ruled this item approved as amended, subject to style to be calendared for second reading this coming August, 2, 2017 regular session with all councilors present as the co-authors and sponsors.
