The hearing was called to order by its chairperson, Hon. Franklin M. Gacal, Jr. to discuss the following agenda:

1. SPPR NO. 1718-01170 – RESOLUTION WAIVING THE PAYMENT OF ANY AND ALL PERMIT FEES AND CHARGES TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF GENERAL SANTOS CITY (LGU-GSC) FOR ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION OF IDENTIFIED INDIGENT BENEFICIARIES OF THE NATIONWIDE INTENSIFICATION OF HOUSE ELECTRIFICATION (NIHE) PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY (DOE).

Mr. Armel R. Adanza, PMS Supervisor of SOCOTECO II explained that this proposed resolution once approved would be the basis that Gensan supports the project. It's is a nationwide project of the DOE in which South Cotabato will be the second batch to avail of this project. He then disclosed the figure of the unserved households in SOCSARGEN area, who are the target beneficiaries, the purpose of the project, and the criteria on how to validate and qualify the prospective beneficiaries. It was then the City Housing & Land Management Office which was tasked to organize applicants and to validate the same for endorsement to the city mayor for him to certify that they are qualified to avail.

The project cost is ₱3,750.00 per connection to be charged to the DOE, ₱2,000 as counterpart of SOCOTECO II for the service connection while the LGU's counterpart are the waived fees and charges.

In determining indigent and 4Ps beneficiaries to qualify for the program, it's the CSWDO that has the authority. The City Housing and Land Management Office was requested to coordinate with the CSWDO to this effect. Thereafter, the chair ruled the same approved to be calendared for second reading in the next regular session.

After hearing from Brgy. Kagawad Isabelita Santiago of Dadiangas West why they have to transfer the amount, the chair hearing no objection ruled the same approved to be calendared for second reading next regular session.

It was learned from Brgy. Kagawad Victor Jordan of Mabuhay that the purpose of this reversion is to purchase a payloader for their barangay.

Mr. Armand Cunanan of the Accounting Office said pursuant to RA 10211, the purchase of which is allowable by law. But when he scrutinized the documents submitted, it was found out that the certification from the Accounting Office was not attached, so the chair ruled this item approved for second reading next regular session with the condition that it be subject to the completion of all documents.
