WHEREAS, the National Land Settlement Administration (NLSA) Office Building was the seat of government powers of the NLSA, which was tasked to manage the first six districts of the Koronadal Valley Project;

WHEREAS, the NLSA Office Building once stood in a 9000+ sq. m. area in what is presently Barangay Lagao, General Santos City;

WHEREAS, this very same ground is the site where the fast food chain Jollibee is currently constructing its branch;

WHEREAS, given the significance of the area to the history and heritage of General Santos City especially to the pioneering spirit of the early settlers, the ground should be properly recognized;

WHEREAS, it is just appropriate that a heritage wall should be built in the Jollibee building complex so as to honor and commemorate the memories, dreams, and aspirations of pioneers and settlers who walked into and transacted business in the NLSA Building as well as to educate the younger generations of the significant role the area played in shaping the history of General Santos City;
