

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. RONNEL C. RIVERA TO UTILIZE A PORTION OF THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND (LDRRMF) – 30% QUICK RESPONSE FUND AMOUNTING TO PHP 3,000,000.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDPs) FROM MARAWI CITY AND NEARBY MUNICIPALITIES OF LANAOS DEL SUR WHO SOUGHT SAFETY IN THE CITY OF GENERAL SANTOS

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2017 Marawi Siege resulted to numerous human loss of life and injuries, displacement of families and damage to properties;

WHEREAS, the affected families in Marawi City are in dire need of assistance in the aftermath of the incident;

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2017 a number of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) from Marawi City arrived the City of General Santos and temporarily staying with their relatives;

WHEREAS, the LDRRMC of the City of Marawi through Resolution No. 60, Series of 2017, declared a state of calamity in the Islamic City of Marawi due to damage caused by the current terrorist attacks in the City and authorized the Honorable City Mayor, Majul U. Gandara to release funds from the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF);

WHEREAS, RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE, President of the Republic of the Philippines, pursuant to Section 18, Article VII of the 1987 Philippines Constitution, proclaimed Martial Law and suspended the privilege of the Writ of Habeas Corpus in the entire island of Mindanao;

WHEREAS, the City Peace and Order Council passed a Resolution No. 08, Series of 2017, resolution extending financial assistance to the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) in Marawi City in the amount of PHP 3,000,000.00 and PHP 2,000,000.00 for the families of the Military personnel who were killed in action during the Marawi Siege;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of City Councilor Franklin M. Gacal, Jr., duly seconded by City Councilors _____, be it;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Ronnel C. Rivera to utilize a portion of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) – 30% quick response fund amounting to PHP 3,000,000.00 for the provision of financial assistance to the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) from Marawi City and nearby municipalities of Lanao del Sur who sought safety in the City of General Santos.
