A prayer-invocation led by Councilor Jose Orlando Acharon along with the General Santos City Performing Arts Choir Division and followed by the community singing of the Philippine National Anthem and the General Santos City Hymn signaled the opening of the session. After thanking the choir, the chair acknowledged the presence of some guests from the Department of Science & Technology headed by its Regional Director, Dr. Zenaida P. HR Laidan and staff, Engr. Rommel Coroña, from BEMAC Company, and the men in uniform, Police Insp. Joel Fomokao, Police Insp. Giovanni Ladeo and PO2 Gladeen Gonzales. Thereafter the Honorable Acting City Vice Mayor called the session to order and the roll call followed. There being a quorum, the chair thereupon ruled to proceed to the next business.

F. READING AND ADOPTION OF MINUTES : 49TH REGULAR SESSION

On separate motions of Councilor Casabuena jointly seconded by Councilors Pacquiao, Acharon, Pestaño and Congson, the reading of the minutes was dispensed with and eventually, it was approved without any correction.

MINUTES OF THE 49TH REGULAR SESSION – ADOPTED

G. PRIVILEGE HOUR:

The first speaker, Councilor Franklin Gacal, Jr. took issue on the apprehension made by the City Police Force allegedly without any warrant of arrest to the employees manning the outlets of Trento Gaming

Corporation, the PCSO's Small Town Lottery agent operating in the city. It can be recalled he said, that the city director in the previous session had declared that the operation of STL in the city is legal. Thus, the arrest on July 24 by the GSC Police force was a classic case of "*hulidap*" because when those apprehended were released the money was already lacking. With the presence of the representatives of the City Police Director, PCI Fomocao and PCI Ladeo, and under suspended rules, they were purposefully grilled alternately by the privileged speaker as to who exactly ordered and conducted the apprehension. When the questioning was done PCI Fomocao admitted that the case was still under investigation and he promised to furnish this sanggunian with the result.

At this instance, Councilor Gacal said his committee will conduct further investigation on this matter. He reminded the police officers that the so-called "verification" is a kind of illegal arrest and they warned them that should they continue this "verification" he would be more than willing to be a lawyer of those would be victims of this "verification" style of the city's police force. Likewise, he said the sanggunian has the power over the PNP and he would like indeed to go deeper on this because there are police officers who had become "sacrificial lambs" due to some erring higher officials in their rank. It was also suggested by Councilor Melliza that in every action of the police officers especially during arrest, everything should be receipted and witnessed by two or more people.

The next speaker, Councilor Dominador Lagare, Jr. after some preliminaries presented to the body the perspective of the proposed Mabuhay Underpass in which a traffic volume survey was recently conducted along the national highway intersecting Mabuhay Road and Bulaong Road. Accordingly, its success would be the final hurdle before the project would be given a go signal.

The privileged speaker at this juncture, introduced to the body the officers and staff of the DOST headed by its Regional Director, Dr. Zenaida P. HR Laidan. Among them was Engr. Rommel Coroña who invented the hybrid road train which was aimed to ferry people all together. The said road train was given to the city allegedly free of charge and right now, it is in Cebu City and would be transported to the city at its expense to the tune of P2.8 Million. A five-minute video clip was presented and after which Engr. Coroña was given a time to speak about his invention.

Various issues and concerns were ventilated by the honorable members regarding the impact of this road train to the traffic problems of the city and its possible route, its lifespan and viability, its maintenance including the fare rate because accordingly, this is not for free ride so as to recover the cost of investment. When all queries were satisfied the chair in behalf of the August Body thanked the DOST people of their laudable contribution not only to the city but to the nation as well.

At this instance, the BEMAC company representatives were given a time in which they also oriented the honorable members of the *e-trike* vehicle, a 3-wheeled electric tricycle, manufactured in the Philippines but all parts particularly the battery and its motor are imported from Japan. Still under suspended rules, the BEMAC people were given a time to promote their product and the presidents of the tricycle associations in the city took turns in ventilating their concerns. Councilor Lagare emphasized his optimism that cooperativism would be the solution to the transportation problem in General Santos City.

The DOST Regional Director, Dr. Zenaida P. HR Laidan, was given a chance to address the August Body after Councilor Lourdes Casabuena had availed of the privilege hour. The latter presented PO2 Gladeen Gonzales who was awarded a Certificate of Commendation for his honesty and integrity when he returned a lost and found wallet that contained P14 thousand pesos to its rightful owner through ABS-CBN.

When recognized, the DOST Regional Director, Dr. Zenaida P. Hadji Raof-Laidan after she was properly introduced by Councilor Lagare of her significant achievements thereupon thanked this body for this opportunity to speak. Thereupon she narrated the actions they had taken as regards the resolutions passed by this sanggunian re: request to build a pilot commercial automated gateway transit system in some major barangays in the city and the request for an instrument that could measure the tolerable levels of foul smells. Likewise she urged the honorable members to encourage the constituency to support the DOST's projects and programs and should they need financial assistance, it should be accompanied by a project proposal. More issues and concerns were discussed and after which a pictorial with the group followed. The chair thanked the DOST officials for gracing this session with their valuable inputs.

Further Councilor Yumang when his manifestation was considered by the chair, he apprised the body of the ongoing construction of bridge connecting Barangay Apopong and Lanton wherein the rerouting of the road affects a portion of the Alcantara Ranch. Since the representative of the Alcantara's was around, also the DPWH, the Traffic Management Officers that man the checkpoint thereat, and other personalities, there followed a quite lengthy discussion. Thereafter, it was the consensus that Engr. Elsa Hormenita of DPWH would write the Alcantaras through Alejandro I. Alcantara for the use of a portion of the Alcantaras pasture lease while the bridge construction is ongoing. Likewise, as regards the need for additional checkpoints in the area, the chair ruled to invite next session the City Police Director and the CO of PP2. Councilor Yumang

then thanked the foregoing officials and employees for their appearance today and their continuing support and cooperation.

When the suspension of the house rules was lifted, the Acting Vice Mayor Bagonoc relinquished the chair to Councilor Gacal.
