MINUTES OF THE HEARING OF THE COMMITTEE ON LAWS, RULES AND REVIEW OF BARANGAY ORDINANCES AND EXECUTIVE ORDERS OF THE 18TH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, CITY OF GENERAL SANTOS

The committee hearing was called to order by its chairperson, City Councilor Jose Edmar J. Yumang, to discuss the following agenda:

1. **SPPR NO. 1718-01301.** – RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE NO. 01, SERIES OF 2017, ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY OF BULA, "REGULATING THE BACKYARD PIGGERY AND SETTING UP A STANDARD DESIGN OF PIG PENS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREOF." (*Hon. Jose Edmar J. Yumang – Author/Sponsor*)

There being no representative from Barangay Bula, the chair ruled this item laid on the table and to conduct another hearing on August 9, 2017 at 1:30 in the afternoon with manifestation that proper notice be given to Punong Barangay Remus P. De Claro. Failure on the part of the barangay to attend will constrain the committee to refer this item back to the barangay.

2. **SPPR NO. 1718-01307.** – RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE RONNEL C. RIVERA, TO ENTER INTO SPECIFIC IMPLEMENTATION ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT-FIELD OFFICE REGION XII (DSWD FO XII), IN REGARD TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOOD PROGRAM (SLP) PROJECTS. (*Hon. Jose Edmar J. Yumang – Author/Sponsor*)

Mr. Jhobert Vidal from DSWD XII informed that the target barangays for this year of the SLP-Pamana program are Barangays Apopong and San Jose. The MOA spells out the role and responsibility in the implementation of the program in the city. Since there is a general MOA approved in 2014, Hon. Yumang said the proposed MOA is a supplemental MOA. Mr. Santos from DSWD added that the general MOA is not yet terminated, therefore, it is still enforceable up to this time.

As to the concerns of Councilors Acharon and Bagonoc, Ms. Niño of DSWD XII clarified that the PWDs are included in the SLP-Pamana program. The SLP regular program refers to the 4Ps while the SLP-Pamana program is for the identified conflict

areas. The beneficiaries identified 10 years ago by a national agency indicated a specific purok which was validated a year ago but was funded just recently. The funding is P500,000.00 per specific purok or barangay. The whole area of Purok Maunlad, Barangay Apopong is the recipient and it has to identify first a community project before the fund will be downloaded by DSWD-national. Both Barangays Apopong and San Jose identified a "bigasan" project.

Thereafter, the chair ruled this item approved on committee level and to be calendared for second reading next regular session.

3. **SPPR NO. 1718-01312.** – RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE NO. 02, SERIES OF 2017, ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY OF CITY HEIGHTS, "PROHIBITING THE COLLECTION, SALE AND USE OF HERMIT CRABS, SPIDERS, MAYA, PUGO, CHICKS, DUCKLINGS AND BUNOT-BUNOT FOR PURPOSES OF ILLEGAL GAMBLING WITHIN BARANGAY CITY HEIGHTS, GENERAL SANTOS CITY." (*Hon. Jose Edmar J. Yumang – Author/Sponsor*)

Brgy. Kagawad Bariquit stated that the barangay received reports that the above-mentioned species are being used as price in "bunot-bunot" outside the school; however, during their inspection, the peddlers immediately kept the species. Aside from that, the students learned to bet by using the hermit crabs in racing. He clarified that once determined that the said species are being used as a price in "bunot-bunot", the same is considered as illegal gambling.

Dr. Gargaran from City Veterinary Office enlightened that under the Animal Welfare Act, peddling/sale should have permit and in fact, these endangered species should be confiscated, in which their office could be of help in this area.

Frogs, mice and cats are allowed to be used in medical school, Hon. Acharon clarified, but as far as turtle and other endangered species and animals, there is already a national law to that effect.

Afterwhich, the chair ruled this item approved on committee level and to be calendared for second reading next regular session.

4. **SPPR NO. 1718-01313.** – RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE NO. 01, SERIES OF 2017, ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY OF CITY HEIGHTS, "REGULATING THE DRINKING OF BEER, LIQUOR OR OTHER ALCOHOLIC OR INTOXICATING BEVERAGES ON PUBLIC STREETS, IN FRONT OF STORES, SIDEWALKS, PARKS, PLAZAS, ALLEYS AND WAITING SHEDS WITHIN BARANGAY CITY HEIGHTS, GENERAL SANTOS CITY." (*Hon. Jose Edmar J. Yumang – Author/Sponsor*)

Brgy. Kagawad Bariquit apprised that this ordinance is to prohibit drinking alcohol outside the residences considering that the barangay is mostly residential zoned and to avoid trouble with drunk individuals. He clarified that drinking liquor outside stores and commercial establishments is prohibited while drinking inside commercial establishments must follow/observe the city ordinance which allowed up to 1:00 A.M. only. For drinking inside residences which is only up to 10:00 P.M. to avoid disturbance

to neighbors, they have to secure permit from the purok and barangay. Later, it was clarified that on parties within the residential area, permit is no longer needed except if done outside private boundary or on sidewalks.

Hon. Bagonoc was of the opinion that since the penalty is very low, it's not really penalizing but only disseminating information on the ill-effects of drinking liquor and promotion of healthy lifestyle.

Thereafter, the chair ruled this item approved on committee level and to be calendared for second reading next regular session.

Hon. Yumang manifested that **Hon. Acharon** and **Hon. Bagonoc** will be included as **co-authors** of all the approved items.

There being no more matter to be discussed, the committee hearing was adjourned at 10:21 in the morning.
