The joint hearing was called to order by City Councilor Jose Edmar J. Yumang to discuss the following agenda:

1. **SPPR NO. 1718-01301.-** RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE NO. 01, SERIES OF 2017, ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY OF BULA, "REGULATING THE BACKYARD PIGGERY AND SETTING UP A STANDARD DESIGN OF PIG PENS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREOF". (*Hon. Jose Edmar J. Yumang - Author/Sponsor*)

Item no. 1 was laid on the table since there were no representatives present.

2. **SPPR NO. 1718-01317.-** RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE CITY MAYOR'S OFFICE - INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY DIVISION (CMO-ICTD), GENERAL SANTOS CITY, TO PROVIDE THE OFFICE OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD TECHNICAL INFORMATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INTERCONNECTION/SETTING UP OF ONLINE LINKAGE OF THE TWENTY-SIX (26) BARANGAY LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (BLGUs) OF GENERAL SANTOS CITY, IN LINE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT 8792, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "ELECTRONIC COMMERCE ACT OF 2000", AND THE PLANS AND PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY (DICT) IMPLEMENTING THE NATIONAL INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (ICT) DEVELOPMENT AGENDA. The chair explained that this program is for the full implementation of Republic Act 8792 where the 26 Barangay LGUs should directly have online linkage to LGU-Gensan for transparency purposes of their barangay activities, budget and financial statements. He

also passed an ordinance implementable for 4 phases within 8 years purposely for crime prevention and transparency. Thereafter, since the representatives of the concerned offices were not around, the chair ruled to lay item no. 2 on the table for another hearing on Wednesday, August 16 at 1:30 in the afternoon with the presence of the concerned offices of DCIT and CMO-ICTD and the 26 barangay captains.

The chair informed that there is a funding for the coconut industry of the city and one of the requirements under the MOA is for the City Treasurer to open an account so that the funds from the national government will be directly downloaded to the City Treasurer in 3 accounts. Thereafter, since there is a need for the concerned invitees to shed light on this matter, the chair ruled item no. 3 laid on the table to be tackled again on Wednesday, August 16 at 1:30 in the afternoon.

4. **SPPR NO. 1718-01322.** – RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE NO. 02, SERIES OF 2017, ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY OF FATIMA, "PROHIBITING THE SALE OF CHICKS, FINGERLINGS, HERMIT CRAB, SPIDERS, MAYA, PUGO, TOP & BUNOT GAMES WITHIN AND BEYOND 100 METERS RADIUS FROM THE DAY CARE CENTERS, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEMENTARY & HIGH SCHOOLS IN BARANGAY FATIMA, THIS CITY" (*Hon. The Barangay Kagawad of Fatima explained the purpose of this ordinance which is for those vendors selling the abovementioned animals. Dr. Calub of the City Veterinary Office clarified that these vendors should secure a permit first from the Bureau of Animal Industry if their activity is in accordance with the Animal Welfare Act which is also the concern of Hon. Bagonoc. Concerning birds (Maya) as inquired by Hon. Pacquiao, this needs permit from City Environment and Natural Resources Office so with the spiders. For fingerlings and hermit crabs, permit should be secured from the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources.

With the foregoing, the chair ruled item no. 4 laid on the table and to be referred back to the Barangay Council of Fatima for refinement of the proposed ordinance amending it to "*to regulate the selling unless they have secured business permit from the aforementioned government agencies*". The representative was also advised to go over the approved ordinance of Barangay City Heights for comparison and guidance.

Brgy. Kagawad Rey D. Curit explained that the purpose of this ordinance is to have coordination between the lodging house owners, MSU dormitories and the barangay and the PNP in order to monitor those transient renters coming from Marawi City. They have problems with lodging houses which are renting for only P88 or P99 for 3 hours as students are involved. Even drugs are rampant when examinations are approaching which they have to monitor the same.

Regarding evacuees coming from Marawi, Hon. Pacquiao advised the barangay to identify them first before they be allowed to rent houses in the barangay just like what was adopted in Barangay Labangal.

Thereafter, some sections were discussed which should be looked into by the barangay as well as the proposed penalties to be imposed which are beyond the barangay's authority. The chair suggested to the representative to make a representation with the City Treasurer to discuss the lease contract of the boarding houses. Thereafter, the chair ruled to lay item no. 5 on the table and to refer this back to the barangay concerned for refinement of the same.

RAMIL G. RABANES, SR. TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE PRC SECRETARY GENERAL, ATTY. OSCAR PALABYAB ON THE GRANT OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE PRC BLOOD SAMARITAN PROGRAM. (Hon. Jose Edmar J. Yumang-Author/Sponsor)

Brgy. Kagawad Laurienz Janine Fernandez of Apopong explained that their aim is to put up an aid amounting to P150,000 for 100 people in Gensan Red Cross Chapter purposely for Barangay Apopong residents. This is in line with the PRC Blood Samaritan Program as contained in the MOA.

After requiring the Red Cross representative to provide the MOA before the next regular session, as moved by Hon. Pacquiao and jointly seconded, the chair ruled item no. 6 approved on committee level to be calendared on the next regular session, subject to the submission of the MOA.
