WHEREAS, pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 1067 or The Water Code of the Philippines, the state shall establish principles and framework relating to the appropriation, control and conservation of water resources to achieve the optimum development and rational utilization of these resources;

WHEREAS, General Santos City Water District (GSCWD) is a government entity mandated to provide potable water supply to the residents of the General Santos City and guarantees that there will always be an adequate supply for all consumers;

WHEREAS, a letter was sent by the General Santos City Water District (GSCWD) last July 27, 2017 to this Sanguniang Panlungod, requesting for a resolution authorizing them to utilize the water from Makar River as an alternative source of potable water for the City;

WHEREAS, this proposal is responsive to the needs of this City as it will help alleviate water scarcity and establish a more efficient use of the water resources for the residents of General Santos City.
